



## TRANSFER OF FUNDS

One of the quickest methods of obtaining money from the U.K. is to have someone, (family/friend) to go to a branch of **WESTERN UNION** and ask for the money to be sent, via their computer link-up, to their agent. You will notice Western Union signs in many parts of the island in particular in Rhodes Town, Faliraki and Lindos. For your convenience, below please note some of the locations where you can find Western Union.

**4. RHODES CENTRAL POST OFFICE**, Mandraki Harbour, Rhodes Town.  
Funds may be obtained on Monday-Friday between the hours of 08.00 – 14.00

You will also find that Post Offices in villages such as lalyssos and Lindos also offer Western Union facilities.

U.K. Depositors can obtain details of their nearest depositing point on **free phone 0800 833833** or arrange a **Credit Card Transfer on 0800 866866**.

To speed up the procedure you must ask the sender to supply you with the following information -

- (1)** The **TRANSACTION NUMBER** given when the money was paid into Western Union
- (2)** The address of the U.K. branch and finally
- (3)** The name of the payee.

You will then need to go to a Western Union Office with this information and complete the necessary paperwork and, providing the money has been deposited correctly, they will be authorised to pay the money to you. There is a transfer charge payable in the U.K. but no charge here in Rhodes.

You can dial direct to the U.K. The international dialling code is 0044 and you must omit the first 0 of the U.K. code. If you are unable to pay for the call you can place a reverse-charge call by dialling 00800 4411 and you will be connected directly to British Telecom in the U.K. or you can place a reverse-charge call from the OTE (Greek Telephone Organisation) at 91 Amerikis Street, Rhodes Town - Opening Hours 06.00 - 23.00

A second method of transferring funds from the UK is to use **EUROCHANGE**. This can be done through Eurochange Branches, Post Offices and Thomas Cook agencies in the UK. The procedure is the same as detailed above whereby the person sending the money will need to give the Transaction Reference Number to the person receiving the money. It may then be collected at the Eurochange Office, which is located in the main Square, opposite the Water Fountain, in the Old Town. Tel: 2410-31847

Eurochange is open 7 days per week between the hours of 09.00- 21.00.
